Her work touches on subjects such as emigration, travel, and choices which are prominent hurdles in the lives of many, but especially challenges many young people and young families in Ireland are faced with in the present climate.

These thought provoking themes are enriched by Caroline's own personal life experiences, portrayed in such a way that they become relatable, inviting and shared with the viewer. The creation of Memories and process of remembering is evident in the pieced togetherness of her work resulting in the visual representation of a journey made by decisions.
